

1. Log in to you EagleNet portal
2. Click "Banner Self Service"
3. Click "Student & Financial Aid"
4. Hover over "Student Records"
5. Click "Degree Evaluation"
6. Select a term, click "Submit"
7. Click "Generate New Evaluation"
8. Click the bubble next to the degree you wish to view, check that the term is correct, click "Generate Request."
