Selected vendors will be notified by or before **February 18, 2022** regarding their status. Selected vendors must submit payment no **more than 5 business days** from the date of notification. If payment is not received in 5 business days, vendors forfeit their participation in the Multicultural Fair. In the event that the Multicultural Fair is cancelled due to circumstances beyond our control, you will be issued a refund in accordance with University Policy and Procedure.

Vendor permits must be completed and returned to the Rappahannock Area Health District no later than **March 4, 2022**. Meal Tax Registration Forms must be submitted to the Fredericksburg Commissioner of the Revenue no later than **March 4, 2022**.

#### COVID-19 Information

While we are now accepting applications for the 2022 Multicultural Fair, please be aware that the Fair might not take place due to the public health realities regarding COVID. If your application is approved and the 2022 Fair does not take place due to the status of the COVID-19 pandemic, as well as the existing guidelines for the Commonwealth of Virginia and the University of Mary Washington, your approved application will extend to the 2023 Multicultural Fair.
