1. **Outcome:** *Students will demonstrate Personal Responsibility.*
 - a. **Goal:** Students will live with honor and integrity by;
 - i. **Objective:** Respecting others and their property,
 - ii. Abiding by University policy,
 - iii. Reflecting on their experiences with honor and integrity.
 - b. Students will work towards achieving goals by;
 - i. Setting or revising goals,
 - ii. Creating a 5 year plan,

 - iv. Reflecting on goals and progress towards achieving established goals.
 - c. Students will live successfully on their own by;
 - i. Exploring basic life skills and competencies that will benefit them after graduation,
 - ii. Exploring personal health and wellness,
 - iii. Demonstrating balance with their academics, leisure activities, and other obligations.
2. *Students will learn and demonstrate Community Responsibility.*
 - a. Students will effectively communicate with others by;
 - i. Using effective communication techniques to advocate for their needs within their living environment.
 - b. Student will be an active and engaged member of their community by;
 - i. Participating in programs sponsored by the Office of Residence Life,
 - ii. Knowing other members of their floor community by name,
 - iii. Providing feedback and suggestions to the Office of Residence Life,
 - iv. Attending complex council events,
 - v. Exploring opportunities for participating in clubs and organizations on campus.
3. *Students will learn and demonstrate Global Responsibility.*
 - a. Student will become humanitarians by;
 - i. Being exposed to a variety of humanitarian causes,
 - ii. Reflecting on their experiences with humanitarian causes.
 - b. Students will engage in community service by;
 - i. Participating in community service and/or philanthropy events,
 - ii. Reflecting on their experiences with community service.
 - c. Students will demonstrate effective leadership by;
 - i. Developing leadership skills,
 - ii. Running for leadership positions,
 - iii. Reflecting on campus involvement and explore potential future leadership opportunities.
