



# COVID-19, UMW, and Conduct

## CONSEQUENCES OF RISKY STUDENT BEHAVIORS

### UNACCEPTABLE BEHAVIORS

Deliberately not using or ineffectively using facial coverings in classrooms, and in other shared spaces, either off campus or on any university property in the presence of others

Not complying with residence hall policies, including hosting students from other residence halls, and visiting students in other residence halls

Deliberately not complying with UMW's MMDC (Monitoring, Masking, Distancing, Cleaning) guidelines and containment efforts

### SANCTIONS CAN INCLUDE

Disciplinary Probation

Removal from UMW housing

### EXTREME RISK BEHAVIORS

Disrespectful or disruptive non-compliance with UMW faculty and staff members (including RAs) enforcing MMDC guidelines

Hosting or inviting others to a gathering of more than ten people, either on or off campus

Interacting in-person with other individuals while exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms

Failure to comply with quarantine/isolation

### SANCTIONS CAN INCLUDE

Removal from UMW housing

Disciplinary Probation

Suspension from UMW

Expulsion from UMW

Students reported to have engaged in any of these or other risky behaviors are subject to being charged with one or more violations of the Code of Conduct, including "Conduct that intentionally or recklessly threatens or endangers the health or safety of any person" and "Violation of published University policies, rules, or regulations."
